

Tree Details

Fir Trees:

Balsam and Fraser Fir

Firs have fragrant, soft, short needles with rounded tips on strong boughs, sheared to an ornament loving shape.



Spruce Trees:

Wisconsin White and Colorado Blue Spruce

Spruce have short, prickly stiff needles on strong branches with blue-green color. Perfect for hanging ornaments.



Pine Trees:

1.Scotch Pines- have stiff needles on strong boughs and are sheared to form a dense, conical shape.

2.Norway/Red Pines- extra long needles softer than Scotch, Stiffer than White on open armed boughs.

3.White Pines - slender, soft needles on weeping boughs.
