Tree Details

Fir Trees:

Balsam and Fraser Fir

Firs have fragrant, soft, short needles with rounded tips on strong boughs, sheared to an ornament loving shape.





Spruce Trees:

Wisconsin White and Colorado Blue Spruce

Spruce have short, prickly stiff needles on strong branches with bluegreen color. Perfect for hanging ornaments.





Pine Trees:

- **1.Scotch Pines** have stiff needles on strong boughs and are sheared to form a dense, conical shape.
- **2.Norway/Red Pines** extra long needles softer than Scotch, Stiffer than White on open armed boughs.
- **3.White Pines** slender, soft needles on weeping boughs.
